
# **RAJASTHAN 2023**



## **NOVEMBER 23: ARRIVAL IN DELHI BY PLANE**



# **NOVEMBER 25: MANDAWA - BIKANER (170 KM, 3 hours)**


Breakfast at the hotel.

After breakfast visit to Havelis. The semi-desert region of Shekhawati, a few hundred km north of Jaipur, is famous for its magnificent painted havelis built by merchants who made their fortunes by supplying the camel trains passing through the ports of Gujarat.

Later proceed towards BIKANER.

On arrival we will visit the Jungarh Fort and check in at the hotel.





NOVEMBER 26: BIKANER - JODHPUR (295 km, 6 hours)

After breakfast we will start our journey by road towards Jodhpur; the trip takes about 6 hours.

# What is Jodhpur all about?

Be it the Mehrangarh Fort or the strength shown by its rulers throughout history, Jodhpur is a living picture of bravery. He fought and stayed alive despite everything that life threw at this place. The Mehrangarh Fort is an architectural masterpiece, as are the stories of its origin. Near this fort we will see blue colored Brahmin houses, once a symbol of the caste of its inhabitants. Stories and well-preserved remnants of war are carved into every corner of this city. The city is proud of its past. Jodhpur's tangled web of streets is filled with small shops that are more than ideal for haggling adventures. The smell of roses, incense sticks and shops selling temple essentials is sheer delight. In addition, there are important war memorials and wonderful bazaars.





#### Unique Taste of Jodhpur (Tour Experience) -

This much-discussed site originated about 500 years ago when the Rathore Rajputs made it the site of their war victory celebrations. Since then till today, Jodhpur has maintained its charisma. The palaces and forts are an important storyteller of the rich heritage of this city and its role in the development of Rajasthan. The robust Mehrangarh fort inspires awe and admiration. Carved out of a low sandstone hill, this prestigious fort will truly amaze you. Its 10 km long wall was once a protection for the inhabitants of the fortress from sudden calamities. The monument built for Maharaja Jaswant Singh II is known by the name Jaswant Thada. Besides this monument, other smaller monuments are also present. The crowded and bustling markets of Jodhpur sell everything related to the city's famous culture. Traditional food is another attraction here.

## **NOVEMBER 27: JODHPUR-RANAKPUR-UDAIPUR (259 km, 6 hours)**

The journey to Udaipur begins. Small break at Ranakpur.

#### Ranakpur -

Ranakpur is a small place between the cities of Jodhpur and Udaipur which has a beautiful Jain temple. Temple, consecrated Tirthankara Adinatha, is known for its architecture and Jain significance. Jains live in nearby areas. The small sun temple also deserves a mention for its unique atmosphere.

After a short visit, we will head towards Udaipur.

#### **Udaipur "City of Lakes"**

A small cafe by the famous Lake Pichola is great for a snack along with a hot cup of coffee. The City Palace offers a glimpse into the life and traditions of the royal family that once built this amazing place.

In the window of your room you will feel the fresh air blowing directly from the lakes. A visit to the City Palace is first on our sightseeing list. The palace offers great views from every corner and is half museum that takes you back 200 years. Coming out of this palace, you come across the famous Jagdish Temple. It is an ancient temple dedicated to Lord Vishnu and is full of positive vibes. Then comes the local market where shops big and small vie for your attention. Buying local clothes, spices and antiques is a good option. Saheliyon ki badi is a small park with blooming roses dedicated to women, meant for fun and frolic. ## NOVEMBER 29: UDAIPUR-PUSHKAR-JAIPUR (380 km, about 8 hours)

After a good night's sleep, we head to Pushkar, which is located at a distance of about 280 km from the "City of Lakes". The trip will take about 6 hours.

#### Pushkar City Tour - Pushkar

is close to Ajmer Dargah and lies at a distance of just 11 km. In its temples you will experience beauty, simplicity and divinity. Listening to morning bells and singing hymns will open your soul for much needed inner refreshment. You can buy amazing things at the local markets with a little haggling. Tie, clothes and banana pancakes are local specialties that can be bought in Pushkar. Enjoy a swim at the Pushkar Ghats and melt away your worries in the holy waters. The sight of small milky white temples and splashing water makes it a place suitable for a reboot. Although you will feel a touch of commercialism here, you will realize that the place has still managed to preserve its true and original self.




#### 1 DECEMBER: JAIPUR -AGRA (256 km): VISIT FATEHPUR SIKRI


